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

## Preventive Services Overview

- CMS recognizes the importance of disease prevention, early detection and lifestyle modifications that support the health of Medicare beneficiaries
- Medicare pays for many preventive benefits, including educating Medicare beneficiaries about potentially life-saving services and screenings

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## Deductible and Coinsurance Waived for Certain Preventive Services

- For DOS on or after 1/1/2011
  - Medicare deductible and coinsurance waived for preventive services included in this presentation
  - <u>CR 7012, "Waiver of Coinsurance and Deductible for Preventive Services, Section 4104</u> of Patient Protection and Affordable Health Care Act, Removal of Barriers to <u>Preventive Services in Medicare"</u>





## Did You Know

A beneficiary must be enrolled in Medicare
 Part B to be covered for any Medicare preventive services





# Ultrasound Screening for Abdominal Aortic Aneurysms

## What is AAA?

- Aneurysm: abnormal bulge or "ballooning" in wall of an artery
  - Most occur in aorta
- Abdominal aortic aneurysm
  - aneurysm that occurs in the aorta in the abdomen





## Ultrasound Screening for AAA

- Procedure that uses sound waves to detect AAA
  - Or other alternative procedure
- Includes interpretation of results





# Benefits of Ultrasound Screening for AAA

- Early identification/detection of AAA
- When detected early, can avoid life-threatening rupture
- Deficit Reduction Act of 2005, Section 5112 provided coverage of the ultrasound screening for AAA
  - Effective for DOS on/after 1/1/2007





## Who is Covered

- Beneficiaries included in at least one high-risk category
  - See high-risk categories on next slide
- Covered for once in lifetime preventive ultrasound





## AAA High Risk Categories

- Family history of AAA
- Males, age 65–75 with history of smoking
- Manifests other risk factors in category recommended for screening through NCD process
  - Coronary heart disease
  - Hypercholesterolemia
  - Hypertension
  - Cerebrovascular disease





## Who Can Perform

- Referral from physician or qualified NPP
- Performed by physician or qualified NPP
  - NP
  - PA
  - CNS





#### Documentation

- Must show screening was ordered by a physician or qualified NPP
- Purpose is early detection of AAA

## Billing Requirements

- Report appropriate diagnosis code
- Line-item billing for ultrasound screening for AAA
  - Report revenue code 040X
  - Report CPT code 76706
    - ✓ Ultrasound abdominal aorta, real time with image documentation, screening study for AAA
  - One unit





# Additional Information for RHCs/FQHCs

- Ultrasound screening for AAA does not qualify as stand-alone billable encounter
  - Report screening as incident to billable encounter
  - If only service performed on DOS, do not submit claim
- Reimbursement included in AIR/PPS payment





## Reimbursement

Facility Type	Basis of Reimbursement
Hospital	Included in OPPS or MPFS
SNF	MPFS non-facility rate
RHC/FQHC	Included in AIR/PPS
CAH Method I	101% of reasonable cost for TC
CAH Method II	101% of reasonable cost for TC, plus 115% of MPFS nonfacility rate for PC





# **Beneficiary Cost-Sharing**

- Effective for DOS on/after 1/1/2011
  - Deductible waived
  - Coinsurance/copayment waived
  - Affordable Care Act Section 4104


