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

#### **Preventive Services Overview**

- Medicare began covering preventive services in 1981
- CMS recognizes the importance of
  - Educating about potentially life-saving services and screenings
  - Early detection and/or prevention of diseases
  - Assisting with/suggesting lifestyle modifications

## Reminders

- Beneficiary must be enrolled in Medicare Part B to be covered for any Medicare preventive services
  - Verify eligibility!
- Each preventive service has certain criteria for coverage and billing guidelines
  - Age, gender, risk factors, frequency, coding
- Understand screening vs. diagnostic services





# Checking Eligibility Using NGSConnex

- Preventive Services section of <u>NGSConnex</u> shows beneficiary eligibility for each preventive service
- Information provided
  - Procedure and Description
  - Modifier
  - Next Eligibility Date
  - Deductible Applies Field will contain 'Yes' when applicable
  - Co-Insurance Applies Field will contain 'Yes' when applicable

#### How Can Medicare Beneficiaries Keep Track of Their Preventive Services?

• Provide your Medicare beneficiaries with the <u>Are You Up-To-</u> <u>Date on Your Medicare Preventive Services</u> checklist so they can track their preventive services.

#### Are You Up-To-Date on Your Medicare Preventive Services?

Medicare pays for many preventive services to keep you healthy. Ask your doctor what services are right for you.

- One time "Welcome to Medicare" preventive visit—get this visit within the first 12 months you have Medicare Part B (Medical Insurance)
- Yearly "Wellness" visit—get this visit 12 months after your "Welcome to Medicare" preventive visit or 12 months after your Part B coverage starts
- Abdominal aortic aneurysm screenings
- Alcohol misuse screenings & counseling
- Bone mass measurements
- Cardiovascular behavioral therapy
- Cardiovascular disease screenings (cholesterol, lipids, triglycerides)
- Cervical & vaginal cancer screenings
- Colorectal cancer screenings
- Counseling to prevent tobacco use & tobaccocaused disease
- COVID-19 vaccines
- Depression screenings

- Diabetes screenings
- Diabetes self-management training
- Flu shots
- Glaucoma screenings

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# **Preventive Services Updates**

#### 2024 – 2025 Vaccine Payment Allowances

- Seasonal influenza (flu) virus vaccines
  - Refer to <u>Vaccine Pricing</u> for payment allowances effective for dates of service 8/1/2024–7/31/2025
  - <u>Change Request 13718</u> (revised)
- COVID-19 vaccines and monoclonal antibodies
  - Certain payment allowances updated based on DOS
    - DOS on/after 8/22/2024
      - 91318, 91319, 91320, 91321, 91322
    - DOS on/after 8/30/2024
      - 91304
  - Refer to <u>Vaccine Pricing</u> for most current payment allowances





### Additional Payment for In-Home Vaccine Administration

- As of 1/1/24, additional payment allowed for administering vaccines to Medicare patients in their homes under certain circumstances
  - G0008 (flu)
  - G0009 (pneumococcal)
  - G0010 (hepatitis B)
  - 90480 (COVID-19)
  - M0201 (in-home add-on payment)
- Change Request 13408
- <u>In-Home Vaccine Administration: Additional Payment</u>





### **Pneumococcal Vaccinations**

- Effective 6/27/24, Medicare coverage requirements updated to align with CDC Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) recommendations
  - Adults aged 65 or older who haven't previously received Pneumococcal Conjugate Vaccine (PCV) or whose previous vaccination history unknown
- CMS IOM Publication 100-02, Medicare Benefit Policy Manual, Chapter 15, Section 50.4.4.2
- MLN Matters<sup>®</sup>: MM13750 Revisions to Medicare Part B Coverage of Pneumococcal Vaccinations Policy





#### Screening for STIs and HIBC to Prevent STIs Update

- Effective 10/1/2023
  - Add CPT 0402U (used for combined chlamydia and gonorrhea testing)
- Change Request 13738
- CMS IOM Publications
  - <u>100-03, Medicare National Coverage Determinations Manual,</u> <u>Chapter 1, Part 4, Section 210.10</u>
  - 100-04, Medicare Claims Processing Manual, Chapter 18, Section 170.1
- <u>NCD 210.10 Screening for STIs and High-Intensity Behavioral</u>
  <u>Counseling (HIBC) to Prevent STIs</u>





### Hepatitis B Vaccine Update

- Physician's order no longer required effective January 1, 2025
  - <u>CY 2025 Physician Fee Schedule</u> final rule
  - MLN Connects<sup>®</sup> issue <u>2024-11-21-MLNC</u>





## **Colorectal Cancer Screening Update**

- Effective on or after 7/29/24
  - Guardant Shield<sup>™</sup> blood-based biomarker colorectal cancer screening test billable under HCPCS code G0327
- <u>NCD 210.3 Colorectal Cancer Screening</u>
- CMS IOM Publications
  - <u>100-03, Medicare National Coverage Determinations Manual,</u> <u>Chapter 1, Part 4, Section 210.3</u>
  - <u>100-04, Medicare Claims Processing Manual, Chapter 18, Section 60</u>





### Diabetes Screening and Diabetes Definitions Policy Updates

- Effective for claims with dates of service on/after 1/1/24, "diabetes" means diabetes mellitus (condition of abnormal glucose metabolism)
  - Specific test-based clinical criteria previously required no longer included in regulatory definition of "diabetes" for purposes of DSMT
- <u>CMS IOM Publication 100-02, Medicare Benefit Policy Manual,</u> <u>Chapter 15, Section 300.1</u>
- <u>Change Request 13487</u>





## Pre-exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP)

- As of 9/30/2024, Medicare covers certain services to decrease beneficiary's risk of acquiring HIV
  - FDA-approved Pre-exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) using antiretroviral drugs to prevent HIV in individuals at increased risk of acquiring HIV
  - Administration of injectable PrEP using antiretroviral drugs to prevent HIV
  - Supplying or dispensing the drug regardless of the route of administration (oral and injectable)
- No cost-sharing applied (deductible or coinsurance)

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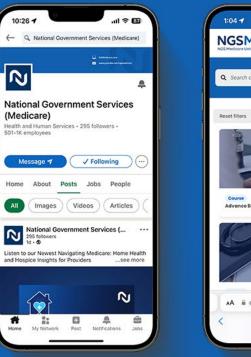
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
