

Important News About Your Medicare Summary Notices Help Save Time, Money and Fight Medicare Fraud!

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has a Go Paperless, Go Green option called the electronic Medicare Summary Notice (eMSN) – THIS IS NOT A BILL for anyone enrolled in Original Medicare. By choosing the eMSN option, you will get an email every month with a secure link to your MSN, instead of waiting 3 months for a paper copy in the mail.

With eMSNs, you can:

- ✓ Help **prevent fraud** by making sure you're billed only for the services you've gotten.
- ✓ Track your claims and costs as soon as they're processed.
- ✓ Check your remaining deductible amount.
- ✓ Catch errors in billing and services.
- ✓ Eliminate stacks of paper – save or print only what you need.
- ✓ Print a copy of your official Medicare card.

Sign up for eMSNs!

Enrolling for eMSN is fast and easy. Go to your computer, smart phone or tablet at <https://www.Medicare.gov/go-digital>.

1. [Log into \(or create\) your Medicare account](#) and select "My account settings."
2. Under the "Email and document settings" section at the top of your account homepage, select "Edit" next to Medicare Summary Notices (MSNs).
3. Under "How do you want to get your MSNs?" select "Electronically" then "Save Changes."
